Rules & Instructions for Scarecrows

Entry is not restricted to residents of Over. Anyone is welcome to take part.

All scarecrows will be displayed in St Mary's Church throughout the weekend of 8th/9th October 2022.

There is no theme, so your scarecrow can be any character you choose to make it.

All scarecrows need to be self supporting they cannot be driven into the ground as they are being displayed indoors.

Suggestions for self supporting are:

mount pole onto a wooden base / use a microphone stand / music stand / Christmas tree stand / parasol stand

Please do not make your scarecrow offensive or scary.

Children will be visiting the festival, so any scarecrow deemed inappropriate will not be displayed.

All scarecrows are to be brought to St Mary's Church on Friday 7th October between 4pm and 8pm.

Scarecrows will be judged by visitors to the exhibition.

In the event of a draw, a deciding vote will be held among members of the organising committee.

A winners' prize-giving ceremony will take place in Church on Sunday at 4pm.

Scarecrows are to be collected on Sunday (9th October) between 4pm and 5pm.

Prizes for the winning scarecrows will be awarded as follows:

1st Prize - £50, 2nd Prize - £20, 3rd Prize - £10.
